Re: Pick-up of your child's medication in the school health office

Dear Parent/Guardian,

If your child has medication in the health office it will need to be picked up a parent/guardian or other designated adult by **Friday, May 26th**. *Any medication not picked up within this time frame will be properly disposed of.*

If your student will require medication for the 2017-2018 schoolyear, the Harrisburg School District requires a new Medication Authorization and Treatment form to be completed. Medication must be delivered directly to the school nurse by a parent/guardian or designated adult in the original packaging. **For your child's safety and the safety of other children, students are not allowed to carry medications, including cough drops, to and from school or while at school.** The only exception is for students needing emergency medications such as Epi-pens or inhalers. If you have any questions about the district's medication policy, please call the school nurse.
